Judy McRae, Kevin's grandmother, was a State representative bowler and was present during the event smiling broadly. Kevin's Dad has bowled 5 x 300 games and Kevin's brother Matthew has also bowled a perfect game. The first game was Kevin's first 300 and now Kevin has recorded Tenpin Bowling Australia Junior Nationals 'first' back to back 300's – well done Kevin.
