FORMAT

Qualifying

Bowlers will qualify by bowling 8 games with handicap in either one or multiple attempts at a cost of \$65 during 3 squads on Friday 9th or Saturday 10th May. The last squad or "desperado squad" will cost \$50 for bowlers having a second attempt.

FINALS – Sunday 11th May

Stage One

The top 24 bowlers who have qualified with handicap will play 4 games at a cost of \$36. Check in for Stage One is 8.30am

Stage Two

After Stage One 4 games the group will be cut to top 16 who will play a further 4 games with handicap at a cost of \$36. Pinfall is carried over from Stage One.

Stage Three

After Stage Two 4 games the group will be cut to top 8 who will play a further 4 games with handicap at a cost of \$36. Pinfall is still carried over from Stage Two.

Stage Four

All pinfall is dropped and the group is cut to top 4 bowlers who will play a one game stepladder with handicap at no cost.

Match One 4 vs. 3

Match Two Winner of Match One vs. 2

Grand Final

Winner of Match Two will play the Tournament leader after Stage Three in a one game sudden death match with handicap to determine the Tournament Champion.

Bowlers must use highest league average as at 1st May 2008 and if visiting from interstate or overseas must have a letter from your association secretary confirming your average.

Bowlers must present in neat attire for qualifying and the final must be bowled in collared shirt and trousers for men, collared shirt and skirt or tailored shorts for women.
