TOURNAMENT ELIGIBILITY, CONDITIONS & RULES

1. This tournament is a scratch event open to all youth bowlers who are 2008 Registered Players of TBA. A Youth is defined as a bowler who has not reached the age of 23 years on January 1st of the current year.

All TBA Rules and Regulations apply.

2. This tournament is a combined Male & Female event. Male & Females bowl in the 1 division.

3. Check-in and briefing will take place 30 minutes prior to each squad starting on day one only.

4. Bowlers must wear acceptable attire, ie collared shirts.

5. The top 16 bowlers will be declared the finalists. Should a tie occur for 16th place after stage 1, a one game playoff will decide the position. The Top 16 Bowlers will progress through to matchplay.

6. Should a tie for 1st place occur after match play, then a one game play-off will decide the position. Should a tie occur for any other position, the prize money for the tied position will be shared.

7. Unsporting behaviour will not be tolerated. All bowlers participating in this event are subject to the TBA Code of Conduct.

8. The tournament directors reserve the right to check any bowlers equipment at any time. Any equipment found to breach TBA regulations will result in disqualification with no claim to any prize money.

9. Bowlers are not permitted to smoke or drink alcohol during a session or series of continuous games in this tournament.

10. The tournament committee will decide any matters not covered in these conditions.

11. Entry fee is \$195.00. A non-refundable \$50.00 deposit is required to accompany your entry.

TOURNAMENT FORMAT & SCHEDULE

Qualifying Format:

All bowlers bowl 12 games in their allocated squad.

Matchplay Format:

The top 16 bowlers in the division will bowl one round of head to head format (15 games) with bonus pins awarded for each game won. 20 pins will be awarded for a win, with 10 pins being awarded for a draw.
