Tournament Eligibility, Conditions and Rules

1. This tournament is a scratch event, open to all bowlers who must attain the age of 50 years and above in the year of competition and are 2009 TBA registered players. NOTE: Registration card must be presented at check-in.
2. All TBA rules and conditions apply. There is to be NO SMOKING when bowling by any participant.
3. TBA senior ranking points will apply to this tournament.
4. Bowlers must wear acceptable attire and a collared shirt.
5. Should a tie occur for first place a one game playoff will determine the winner. Should a tie occur for any other position, prize money will be divided equally between players.
6. Unsporting behaviour will not be tolerated, all bowlers participating in this event are subject to the *TBA Code of Conduct*.
7. Random checks to bowler's equipment may be carried out at anytime. Any equipment found to be in breach of TBA regulations will result in disqualification with no claim to prize money.
8. Should any protests or infractions occur, notification in writing must be received by the tournament committee no later than 30 minutes after the infraction has occurred.
9. Entry Fee is \$195.00. A \$50.00 non-refundable deposit is required to secure your position in your preferred squad NOTE: Each squad will only hold 36 participants.
10. The tournament committee will decide any occurrences not covered in these rules.
