Tournament Rules & Regulations

- **This is a Ranked Youth Event.** This tournament is open to all TBA registered bowlers under the age of 23 as at 1st January 2010. TBA registered players cards are required to be presented when bowlers check in.
- **TBA Rules and regulations shall apply.**
- **No Mobile phones may be used while bowling.**
- **No smoking is permitted during competition**
- **CHECK-IN** time shall be at least 30 minutes prior to bowlers scheduled squad time. The time will be that of the Oz Tenpin Geelong clock. No late entries will be accepted.
- **DRESS CODE** shall apply to all bowlers. Bowlers must wear acceptable attire at all times. Tailored trousers / skirts and bowling / collared shirts preferred. TD discretion will apply.
- **BOWLING BALLS** must meet correct specifications. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to examine the balls used by the participants. Use of an illegal ball is grounds for forfeiture of game, prizes, standings and possible disqualification.
- **TIE-BREAKERS** in the event of a tie for 10th place (Male) or 8th place (Female) during the qualifying round, a single game roll-off will occur to decide position.
Should a tie occur on pinfall in any of the stepladder matches, a 10th frame roll off will apply.
- **PROTESTS** MUST be lodged with the Tournament Director within 15 minutes of the completion of bowling in which the incident occurred. In the case of a Matchplay or stepladder round, protests are to be lodged prior to the next round.
In the last match of the final such protest, if any, should be addressed to the Tournament Committee before prize presentation.

Saturday 17th July - Qualifying Round

All entrants will complete 10 games in one appearance in their nominated squad.
Games to be bowled in 5 blocks of 2 games.
Moving lanes odds to left & evens right by two pairs.

At the conclusion of the 10 games qualifying the top **10 Males** and top **8 Females** will progress to the "Matchplay" stage.

Pinfall carries over to Matchplay Round

Sunday 18th July - Matchplay Round

Top **10 Males** will bowl a further 9 games matchplay.
Top **8 Females** will bowl a further 7 games matchplay.
Bonus Pins: 20 for win, 10 for draw, 0 for loss
Total Pinfall + Bonus Pins will determine position.
Top 5 Male & Top 5 Female progress to stepladder

Sunday 18th July - Stepladder Finals

Should a tie occur on pinfall in any of the stepladder matches, a 10th frame roll off will apply.

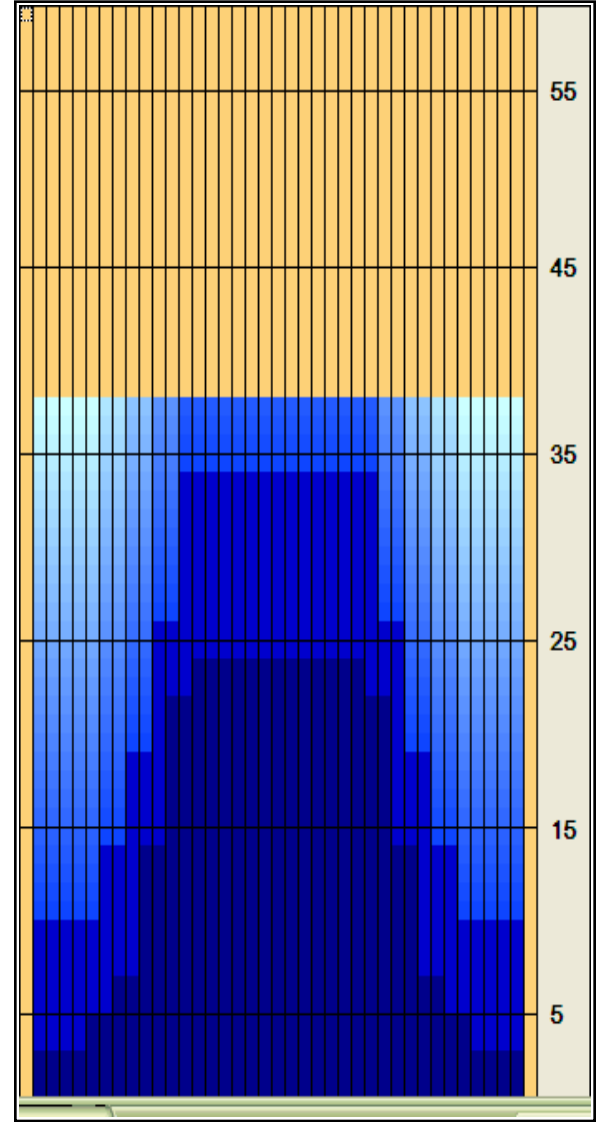
