Australian female bowlers who participate in the scratch divisions will also compete for the right to represent Australia in the 46th QubicaAMF World Cup in Zagreb, Croatia from October 15th to 24th 2010.

QUALIFYING FORMAT

All bowlers will bowl 14 games (8 games Friday, 6 games Saturday). The top 10 open bowlers (Australian residents) from Qualifying will advance to the World Cup Qualifying matchplay on Saturday afternoon. The top 10 open bowlers from qualifying and top 10 graded bowlers (handicap added) will advance to the Vic 150 finals on Sunday.

WORLD CUP QUALIFYING

Pinfall from qualifying will carry over. The top 10 open bowlers will bowl 9 games of matchplay with 20 bonus pins for a win and 10 bonus pins for a draw. The bowler with the highest pinfall including bonus pins will win the right to represent Australia in the 2010 Qubica AMF World Cup.

VIC 150 FINALS FORMAT

All previous pinfall will be dropped. The top 10 Open and graded bowlers will be paired in to doubles.

Pairings: 1st placed open bowler will be paired with the 10th placed graded bowler and down to the 10th placed open bowler with the 1st placed graded bowler.

Teams will bowl 9 matchplay games with the bonus points system applying (20 pins per team win, 10 pins per team draw, nil for a team loss)

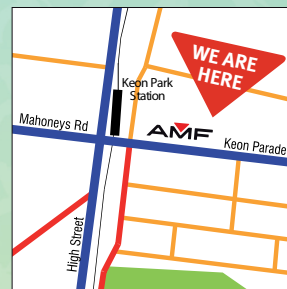

1. This is a TBA Rankings event open to Female bowlers who are registered members of the TBA. All games will be bowled in accordance with TBA Rules and Regulations.
2. No bowler is permitted to have more than one entry in this event.
3. Check-in and briefing is detailed in the tournament schedule on day one only.
4. Bowlers must wear acceptable attire. Jeans and track suits are not permitted. Please note dress shorts are permitted.
5. Should a tie occur for 10th place in either division, the tie will be broken with a one game play off.
6. The Tournament Director reserves the right to check any bowlers equipment at any time. Any equipment found to breach TBA regulations will result in disqualification with no claim on any prize money.
7. Bowlers are not permitted to smoke whilst actually competing in this tournament.
8. In the Graded section the highest league average as at 31st December 2009 will be used. The handicap applied will be 90% of 200. The average must be achieved in a registered centre.
9. Any matters not covered in these conditions will be decided by the Tournament Directors whose decision will be final.
