Tournament Rules and Conditions

This tournament is a scratch event open to all TBA Registered Youth bowlers. A Youth is defined as a bowler who has not reached the age of 21 years on January 1st of the current year.

This is an Open Event where male and female bowlers are competing equally for the same prize fund. The event is a TBA ranked tournament for Youth bowlers.

All games will be bowled in accordance with the TBA rules and regulations. TBA registered player cards must be presented at check-in.

No bowler is permitted to have more than one entry in this event.

Bowlers must wear neat and acceptable attire. Trousers, skirts or shorts must be tailored.

Lanes will be dressed prior to each squad

The tournament Director reserves the right to check any bowler's equipment at any time. Any equipment found to breach TBA regulations will result in disqualification with no claim on any prize money.

Bowlers are not permitted to smoke while actually competing in this tournament.

Any bowlers not checked in by the advertised time will be disqualified and will have no claim on any prize money nor have any deposit on entry refunded.

Ties: A tie for 12th place after Stage 1 or 6th place after Stage 2 will be decided by a 10th frame playoff.

A tie for 1st place at the completion of match play will be decided by a 1 game playoff.

Any other ties after match play will share the prize money for the tied positions.

Any matters not covered in these conditions will be decided by the Tournament Director whose decision will be final.

TOURNAMENT FORMAT

Stage 1 – Qualifying:

All bowlers will bowl 10 games in their nominated squad. Pinfall will carry over into Stage 2.

Stage 2 – Sprint:

The top 12 bowlers from Stage 1 will bowl an additional 6 games. Stage 2 bowlers not checked in by the specified time will be replaced by reserves and forfeit any rights to receive prize fund. Pinfall will carry over into Stage 3

Stage 3 – Match play:

The top 6 bowlers from Stage 2 will bowl 5 games of match play, scoring 20 pins for a win & 10 pins for a draw.

Final placing's will be decided by total pinfall plus bonus pins at the completion of matchplay.
