PHASE 1

QUALIFYING

All entrants will bowl 12 games in succession in a single appearance. Each entrant will make a lane change after every two game block. Check-in is 30mins prior to each squad. After completion of the qualifying phase, the top 18 bowlers will progress to phase 2. In the event of a tie for 18th place, a one game roll off will break the tie and the winner will go on to compete in phase 2

PHASE 2

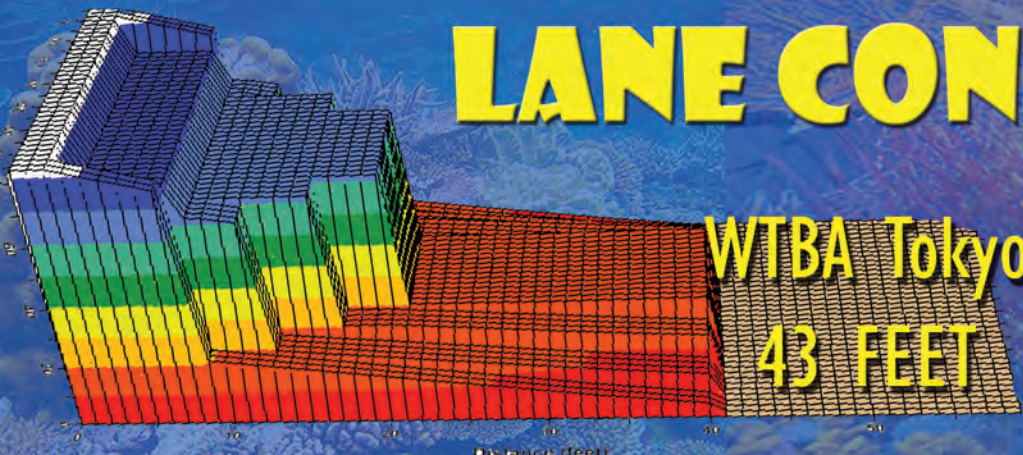
The top 18 bowlers from qualifying will play 3 x 2 game blocks. Pinfall from the previous phase will carry over. After completion of phase 2, the bottom six bowlers based on pinfall will be eliminated. The remaining top twelve bowlers will progress to phase 3. In the event of a tie for 12th place, a one game roll off will break the tie and the winner will go on to compete in phase 3

PHASE 3

MATCHPLAY

Pinfall from previous phases of the competition will be dropped. The twelve remaining bowlers will bowl 11 matchplay games, receiving 20 bonus points for a win and 10 for a draw. The bowler with the highest pinfall plus bonus after twelve games will be crowned Innisfail Open Champion of 2012. In the event of a tie, a one game roll off will break the tie so an outright winner can be named.

Tournament Rules and Regulations

- The 2012 Innisfail Open is a scratch ranked event open to all bowlers who are current registered members of Tenpin Bowling Australia
- All bowlers must produce a 2012 Registration Card or receipt of payment during check in.
- This event is accredited by TBA and all stages of the tournament will be played in compliance with all TBA rules and regulations.
- No bowler is permitted to have more than one entry.
- Bowlers must wear suitable bowling attire. Denim, T-shirts and track pants are not permitted. Please contact the tournament director with any matters concerning the dress code. The top 12 finalists are required to wear black or navy trousers for men or black or navy skirts or dress shorts for ladies.
- The tournament director reserves the right to inspect participating bowlers equipment at any time. Equipment in breach of TBA rules and regulations will result in instant disqualification with no right of claiming prize money, nor refund of entry fees.
- Unsporting conduct will not be tolerated and all bowlers participating are subject to the TBA code of conduct.
- Bowlers will not be permitted to smoke or consume alcohol whilst actually competing in the tournament.
- Late arrivals during any stage of the competition will be replaced by the highest placed available reserve.
- No competitor is eligible for more than one bonus payout. The average used to be eligible for the Handicap bonus is the highest league average over a minimum of 24 games, but must not exceed 180. Bowlers with averages exceeding 180 are not eligible for the handicap bonus payout.
- Proof of average must be supplied at check-in and verified by the tournament director.
- Guidelines for bonus payouts for Youth and Seniors will be such as set out by TBA
