1. This tournament is a scratch event, open to all bowlers who must attain the age of 50 years and above in the year of competition and are 2012 TBA registered players.
NOTE: Registration card must be presented at check-in.
2. All TBA rules and conditions apply. There is to be NO SMOKING when bowling by any participant.
3. TBA senior ranking points will apply to this tournament.
4. Bowlers must wear acceptable attire and a collared shirt.
5. If a tie occurs for 1st place equal champions will be declared and 1st and 2nd place prize fund will be divided and third place prize money will be paid to 2nd.
6. Unsporting behaviour will not be tolerated, all bowlers participating in this event are subject to the *TBA Code of Conduct*.
7. Random checks to bowler's equipment may be carried out at anytime. Any equipment found to be in breach of TBA regulations will result in disqualification with no claim to prize money.
8. Should any protests or infractions occur, notification in writing must be received by the tournament committee no later than 30 minutes after the infraction has occurred.
9. Entry Fee is \$200.00. A \$50.00 non-refundable deposit is required to secure your position in your preferred squad NOTE: Each squad will only hold 40 participants.
10. The tournament committee will decide any occurrences not covered in these rules.
