QUALIFYING

All bowlers will bowl 10 games in one appearance. The top 16 males and 16 females after qualifying will progress to Stage 2.

STAGE 2

The top 16 males and 16 females will bowl 8 games. Pinfall will carry over from qualifying. The top 8 in each division after Stage 2 will progress to Stage 3.

STAGE 3

The top 8 in both divisions will bowl 6 games. Pinfall will carry over from Stage 2 and the top 2 in both divisions after Stage 3 will progress to the Final.

FINAL

The top 2 in both divisions will bowl a best of 5-game head-to-head match. The top seed has the right to choose their starting lane. Pinfall will be dropped and the winner of the 5-game head-to-head match will be declared the **2012 Tenpin SA Youth Masters Champion**.

RULES AND REGS

TENPIN SA YOUTH MASTERS 2012

- This tournament is open to all TBA Registered Players who had not reached the age of 21 years as of the 1st January 2012.
- This is a TBA Nationally Ranked Youth Tournament and all TBA Rules and Regulations apply. This includes the requirement for bowlers to present their 2012 TBA Registered Players Card at check-in for their qualifying squad.
- Bowlers not checked in by the advertised time will be disqualified.
- **DRESS CODE:** All bowlers are requested to wear a collared shirt or bowling industry manufactured shirt. Males are to wear long pants. Females may wear slacks, shorts, skirts or $\frac{3}{4}$ pants. No jeans, cargo pants, tracksuit pants, T-shirts, tank tops or hats are to be worn whilst competing. The Tournament Director will make the final decision regarding appropriate attire.
- The Tournament Director reserves the right at any time to check any bowler's equipment. Any equipment that is found to be in breach of the TBA rules will result in disqualification of that bowler with no claim to any prize money.
- The TBA Code of Behaviour will apply to this tournament and will be enforced in accordance with that policy.
- No bowler will be permitted to smoke or consume alcohol during the tournament.
- Any appeals or protests must be lodged with the Tournament Director within 30 minutes of the alleged infringement.
- Entries will be accepted until squads are full.
- Bowlers will be permitted only one entry.
- Should there be a tie for the final qualifying position a one-game roll-off bowled at 8:45am Sunday 5th August will decide the bowler who makes the final.
- If any ties occur for the final position to qualify for the next stage (excluding qualifying) the bowler with the highest last game will take precedence.
- If there is a tie after the completion of the Final 5-game head-to-head match the bowler with the highest pinfall will be declared the winner.
- If this fails to break the tie at the completion of the Final then a one-game roll-off will be conducted. If needed additional 10th frame roll-offs will be conducted until a winner emerges.
- No refunds will be issued for bowlers withdrawing from the tournament after play has commenced.
- Submitting a nomination is acceptance of these rules and regulations and as such no claims of ignorance will be accepted.
- Any matters not covered by these rules will be under the jurisdiction of the Tournament Director whose decision will be final.
