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Welcome

Welcome to the 28th running of the Vic 150. This year's event is proudly sponsored by Grouped Property Services Vic 150. Australian female bowlers who participate in the scratch division will also compete for the right to represent Australia in the 48th Qubica AMF World Cup.

Qualifying Format

All bowlers will bowl 16 games (8 games on Friday, 8 games on Saturday). The top 12 open bowlers and top 12 graded bowlers (handicap added) will advance to the Vic 150 finals on Sunday.

World Cup Qualifier.

Pinfall from qualifying will carry over in the finals. The open bowler with the highest scratch average over 27 games will represent Australia in the 2012 World Cup.

Vic 150 Finals

PINFALL WILL CARRY OVER for both scratch and handicap bowlers. The 12 open bowlers and the top 12 graded bowlers will be paired into doubles.

Pairings: 1st placed open bowler will be paired with the 12th placed graded bowler and the 12th placed open bowler with the 1st placed graded bowler.

Teams will bowl 11 match play games with the bonus system applying (20 pins per team win, 10 pins per team draw, nil for a team loss)

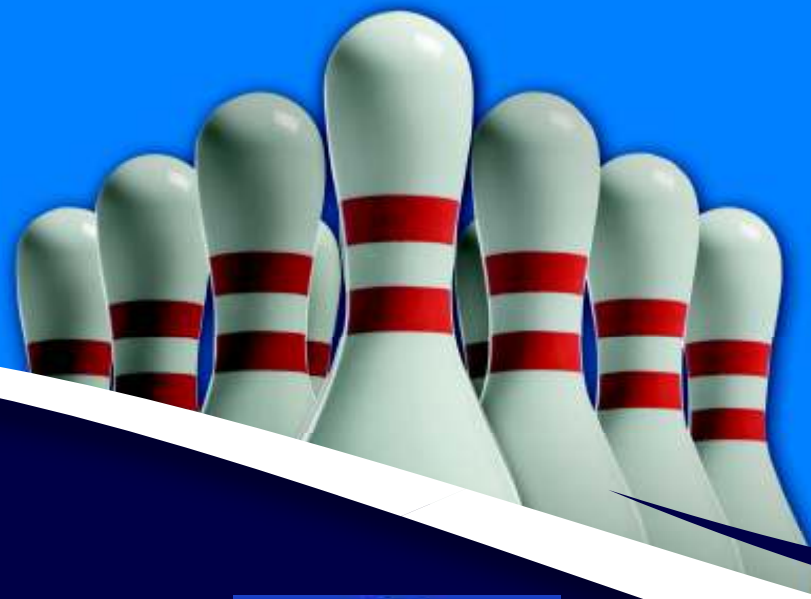

Tournament conditions

1. This is TBA Ranked event open to Female bowlers who are registered members of the TBA. All games will be bowled in accordance with TBA Rules and Regulations. TBA registered cards must be presented on check-in.
 2. No bowler is permitted to have more than one entry in this event.
 3. Check in and briefing is detailed in the tournament schedule on day one only.
 4. Bowlers must wear acceptable attire. Jeans and track suits are not permitted. Please note dress shorts and ¾ pants are permitted.
 5. Should a tie occur for 12th place in either division, the tie will be broken with a one game play off.
 6. The tournament director reserves the right to check any bowlers equipment at any time. Any equipment found to breach TBA regulations will result in disqualification with no claim on any prize money.
 7. Bowlers are not permitted to smoke whilst actually competing in this tournament.
 8. In the Graded section the highest league average as at the end of December 2011 will be used. The handicap applied will be 90% of 200. The average must be achieved in a registered centre.
 9. Any matters not covered in these conditions will be decided by the Tournament Directors whose decision will be final.
