Tournament Rules and Conditions

This Tournament is a scratch event. Entry is open to all 2012 TBA Registered/Affiliated bowlers who attain the age of 50 years or above in the year of the competition (proof of age is required).

TBA registered cards must be produced by each competitor at check-in.

TBA Ranking points will be applied to participants who are TBA silver members and registered for Ranking points prior to the event.

All TBA Rules and Regulations will apply.

Smoking by players during competition will not be allowed.

Only one entry per bowler is permitted for this event. This tournament will have separate divisions for Males and Females.

Check-in and briefing will take place 30 minutes prior to initial squad on day one, sign in at counter 15 mins prior to squad on day two

Bowlers are to wear a collared shirt with their own name and dress pants/slacks/shorts.

Each competitor will bowl eighteen (18) games over two days. At the completion of the eighteen games, the bowler with the highest pinfall in each division will be declared the winner of the 2012 Western Australian Seniors Cup.

There will be 2 Squads, with a maximum of 32 in each squad, 4 bowlers per pair.

Lanes will be dressed

Sunday 5th August

B Squad – sign-In by **8.45 am** for a **9.00 am** start – Bowl 8 Games
(4 blocks x 2 games)
Lanes will be dressed

A Squad – sign-In by **12.15 pm** for a **12.30pm** start – Bowl 8 Games
(4 blocks x 2 games)
Lanes will be dressed
