### Race for Bronze another cliff-hanger in Grand Senior Women's Doubles

The Japanese duo of Tomoko Yoshikawa and Kazumi Koike came out of the blocks firing with back to back 447 games in the Grand Senior Women's Doubles event this evening - the pair clinched Gold with an overall pinfall, with handicap, of 2473 ahead of team-mates Masako Takamoto and Harumi Chatani. The race for Bronze was another cliff-hanger, with Korea's Myung Suk Park and Soon Nam Choi earning Bronze by a narrow 2 pin margin over Junko Kuji and Misako Karatsu from Japan.

Going into tomorrow's Team of Four events, Australia's John Sullivan leads the Grand Senior Men's All Events tally ahead of fellow Victorian Robert Zikman, Mike Talevski from Australia leads the Senior Men's All Events ahead of Soo Ho Lee from Korea and Korean Hwa Ja Lee has a comfortable lead in the Senior Women's All Events, with team-mate Gwi Nam Kim and Australia's Julie Harrison in hot pursuit of All-Events medal honours.

The first block of the Men's Senior and Grand Senior Team of Four events will begin at 9am Monday morning, with the Senior and Grand Senior Women's Team events scheduled for 1.30pm, following the Doubles medal presentation ceremony.
