QUALIFYING FORMAT

All Bowlers will bowl 16 Games qualifying in their respective squad (8 Games Friday, 8 Games Saturday). At the completion of qualifying, the top 14 bowlers will advance to the Match Play finals on Sunday.

AUSTRALIAN OPEN FINALS

PINFALL WILL CARRY OVER FROM QUALIFYING. The top 14 Bowlers from qualifying will bowl 13 games match play with the bonus system of 20 pins for a win, 10 pins for a draw and 0 pins for a loss. At the completion of the match play, the bowler with the highest pinfall (including bonuses) will be declared the 2013 UTBA Australian Open Champion.
