TOURNAMENT CONDITIONS

1. This is a TBA Ranked Event open to Female Bowlers who are registered members of TBA. All games will be bowled in accordance with TBA Rules and Regulations
2. TBA registered cards must be presented on check in
3. No Bowler is permitted to have more than one entry in this event
4. Bowlers must wear acceptable attire. Jeans and track suits are not permitted. Dress Shorts and ¾ pants are acceptable.
5. Should a tie occur for 8th Place after qualifying in the scratch division, 1st Place after the finals, or for 1st Place in the Graded Division, the tie will be decided by a one game play off. Should a tie still exist after the play off, the 10th frame will be re-bowled until the tie is decided
6. The Tournament Director reserves the right to check any bowlers equipment at any time. Any equipment found to breach TBA regulations will result in disqualification with no claim on any prize money
7. In the Graded Division the highest league average as at the end of December 2012 will be used. The handicap applied will be 90% of 200. The average must be achieved in a registered centre.
8. Bowlers are not permitted to smoke whilst actually competing in this tournament
9. Any matters not covered in these conditions will be decided by the Tournament Directors whose decision will be final
10. *The right to represent Australia at the 2013 World Cup will be only awarded to the highest placed Australian female Resident in the Scratch Division.

QUALIFYING FORMAT – SCRATCH DIVISION

All Bowlers will bowl 16 Games qualifying in their respective squad (8 Games Friday, 8 Games Saturday). At the completion of qualifying, the top 8 bowlers in the Scratch Division will advance to the Match Play finals on Sunday.

GRADED DIVISION

All bowlers will bowl 16 Games in their respective squad (8 Games Friday, 8 Games Saturday). At the completion of the 16 Games, the bowler with the highest pinfall (including Handicap) will be declared the 2013 VIC 150 Graded Champion..

FINALS – SCRATCH DIVISION - PINFALL WILL CARRY OVER FROM QUALIFYING.

The top 8 (Scratch Division) Bowlers from qualifying will bowl 7 games match play with the bonus system of 20 pins for a win, 10 pins for a draw and 0 pins for a loss. At the completion of the match play, the bowler with the highest pinfall (including bonuses) will be declared the 2013 VIC 150 Open Champion.

WORLD CUP REPRESENTATIVE – Scratch Bowlers Only.

The right to represent Australia at the 2013 AMF World Cup will be awarded to the highest placed Australian Female resident at completion of the Open Division match play. Travel costs to attend the 2013 World Cup will be subsidised to a maximum amount of \$2000. Any other costs incurred will be the responsibility of the bowler attending.
