2013 WERRIBEE YOUTH CUP

Rules:

- This tournament is open to all TBA registered youth and junior bowlers. A Youth is defined as a bowler who has not reached the age of 21 years on January 1st of the current year, and junior is defined as a bowler who has not reached the age of 18 on January 1st of the current year.
- **Please note that in accordance with new TBA Youth policies this event is restricted to Under 21 years of age.**
- TBA registered cards (or proof of purchase) are required to be presented at Check-in. It is advisable that participants register with TBA online prior to commencement of the event.
- This event will be a TBA ranked tournament for youth/junior bowlers based upon the bowler's scratch scores. Bowlers outside of match play will receive ranking points based on their qualifying position.
- Bowlers are required to check-in at the tournament room prior to the designated time each day of the tournament. Bowling will commence after a short briefing.
- TBA Rules and Regulations shall apply at all times.
- No Smoking is permitted during the Tournament.
- Unsporting conduct will not be tolerated.
- Mobile phones must be switched off whilst bowling
- Any bowler wishing to leave the lanes during this tournament must first obtain the permission of the Tournament Director or an event official.
- Protest specified infringements / offences must be lodged with the Tournament Director immediately. Other protests and concerns are to be lodged within 15 minutes of the completion of the said squad.
- Dress Code – All bowlers are required to wear neat, suitable attire at all times. Bowling shirts, trousers/skirts are preferred (jeans, track pants, leggings, bike shorts or offensive language on T-shirts are not permitted). Ladies may bowl in tailored shorts/pants. Men will be permitted to wear **tailored shorts**. TD discretion will apply.
- Bowlers not checked in by the advertised time will be disqualified and will have no claim on any prize money nor have any deposit on entry refunded.

Travel

Tullamarine Airport to Werribee Superbowl is a 30-minute taxi ride and will cost approx. \$70.00. Avalon Airport is only a 15 minute drive from Werribee and a taxi should not cost more than \$55.00 (based on rates 30/7/2012).

Ample car parking is available at Werribee Superbowl for those that choose to drive.

Please note that it will be the bowler's responsibility to call the centre and verify qualifying results. Centre Management will do their best to ensure that all information is available via the TBA and Total bowling website by end of play on Saturday for bowlers to view.

PLEASE NOTE:

SQUAD PREFERENCES WILL ONLY BE CONFIRMED AFTER A DEPOSIT HAS BEEN PAID. WE WILL ALLOW 7 DAYS FROM DATE OF INTEREST FOR DEPOSITS TO ARRIVE, AFTER THIS TIME THE PLACE WILL BE ALLOCATED TO THE NEXT BOWLER. PHONE DEPOSITS (WITH A CREDIT CARD) IS AVAILABLE FOR YOUR CONVENIENCE. DEPOSITS WILL NOT BE REFUNDABLE FOR "NO SHOWS" OR AFTER ANY NOTIFICATION LATER THAN 10AM FRIDAY 1st MARCH 2013.

Stage 1 - Qualifying

All bowlers will bowl 10 games in one appearance in their nominated squad. The top 15 boys and 15 girls (based on pinfall) will qualify into the next stage on day 2. All bowlers who have not qualified will then have handicap, based on their entering average, added to pinfall to determine graded placings.

In the event of a tie for the final qualifying position, a single game will be played to break the tie. Any subsequent tie will require a 10th frame playoff until the tie is broken.

Stage 2 – Match play

Top qualifying 15 Boys and top qualifying 15 girls will bowl an additional 7 games in a 3 per pair format.

Point system:

BONUS 20 pins - 1st place
10 pins - 2nd place
0 pins - 3rd place

15 pins DRAW - 1st place 2 way tie
10 pins DRAW - 1st place 3 way tie
5 pins DRAW - 2nd place 2 way tie

GRADED CONSOLATION PRIZE MONEY:

The remainder of the field will then have handicap added to their stage 1 pinfall. The leading 8 bowlers will be awarded prize money. Handicap will be **90% of 210**. Winner will be decided on accumulated pinfall with handicap. There will be no extra bowling for graded consolation round for 2013 –places will be awarded based on qualifying. Averages submitted are to be taken from bowlers highest league or accredited tournaments over 18 games, whichever is the highest.
