2013 National Youth Cup and the National Youth Team Challenge announcement

Tenpin Bowling Australia Limited is delighted to announce that the 2013 National Youth Cup and the National Youth Team Challenge will be held at AMF Joondalup in WA.

Dates:

National Youth Cup Sat 12th and 13th January 2013.

National Youth Team Challenge Monday 14th to Thursday 17th January, 2013.

Location: AMF Joondalup is located at 23 Franklin Lane, Joondalup, WA, 6027. The Centre has 32 AMF HPL Synthetic lanes with AMF 82-70 machinery (with XL1 upgrades) and a Kegel Lane Walker oiling machine.

The customary mode of transport of Teams for the event is by bus with a luggage trailer. Hire companies can provide these for all groups to pick-up and drop-off at Perth Airport. Contact can be organised with hire companies to cater for individual group requirements.

The trains are a convenient and easy way to travel into the Perth CBD for shopping or accommodation purposes, the railway runs parallel with the Mitchell Freeway.

Travel by car or bus to Joondalup is directly from the airport via Tonkin-Reid Highway and Mitchell Freeway. The distance is approximately 35 kilometres, Airport to Joondalup Bowl and can be made in around 45 minutes. Travel 1km to Tonkin Hwy, 8km on Tonkin, 11.5km on Reid, 12km on Mitchell and 1.5km to Joondalup Bowl.

AMF Joondalup is within walking distance of the city centre, train and bus stations. Across the main road is the huge Lakeside Joondalup City shopping centre. The bowling centre is situated close to the Mitchell Freeway and other major roads.

An island-reception is situated near the entrance door to provide convenient attention on entering the facility. Adjacent is the bar area and licensed seating for alcohol consumption is in the separate Sports Bar to the right of the bar. To the left are the arcade, café seating, and café and meeting room.

The block immediately to the right of the entrance is the pro-shop, office and toilet block.

Accommodation: Options include a wide variety of styles, including Motels, Hotels, Caravan Parks and self contained apartments within close proximity to the Centre.
