Tournament Rules & Regulations

- This tournament is open to all TBA registered bowlers under the age of 21 as at 1st January 2014. TBA registered cards (or proof of purchase) are required to be presented at check in.
- This event will be a nationally ranked tournament for Silver TBA members.
- TBA Rules and Regulations shall apply.
- No smoking is permitted during competition.
- Mobile phones must be switched off while bowling.
- Bowlers are required to report to the Tournament room and have entry fee paid by the designated check in time.
- Dress code shall apply to all bowlers. Bowling shirt, dress pants, dress shorts or skirt.
- All equipment must be in accordance with TBA regulations. The tournament committee reserves the right to check any equipment.
- Handicap for graded consolation will be 90% of 220, averages submitted are to be taken from highest league or tournament over 18 games, as at 31st July 2014. There will be no extra bowling for graded consolation, places will be awarded based on qualifying pinfall.
- Any tied positions at the completion of qualifying or matchplay will be decided by highest last game played.

Any matter not covered here will be decided by the Tournament Committee

Format

The oil pattern will be WTBA Atlanta

Saturday 27th September Qualifying

All bowlers will complete 10 games in their nominated squad.

At the completion of qualifying the top 14 male and 8 female bowlers will progress to the "Matchplay" stage.

Pinfall will carry over.

Graded Consolation

The non-cashing remainder of the field will then have handicap added to their qualifying pinfall, top 6 bowlers will be awarded prize money.

Sunday 28th September Finals

Top 14 Males play 13 games matchplay.
Top 8 women play 7 games matchplay.

Bonus pins: 20 for a win, 10 for a draw.
Total Pinfall plus bonus pins will determine positions.
