RULES AND GENERAL INFORMATION

RULES - All TBA Tournament Rules and Regulations will apply. Accreditation Numbers Tournament : **A11/0009** State Teams Challenge: **A11/0012**

ELIGIBILITY - This tournament is open to all TBA Registered Players in good standing who meet the requirements of a bowler with a disability under TBA rules on or prior to the first day of the Championship.

DRESS CODE - Bowler's must wear neat acceptable attire. No jeans, T shirts, tank tops or hats are to be worn whilst competing.

ENTERING AVERAGES - Each bowler must use their highest current league average as at the 19th March, 2011 which has been established over a minimum of 18 games. During league in a TBA Registered centre If bowlers have more than 18 Games then the average is taken over the entire league . League History to be attached with entry form. Must be an authorized print out from the Bowling Centre scoring system.

GRADINGS - Based on averages submitted, entries will be Graded in accordance with the Australian Disability Championship Gradings Table.

BOWLERS WITHOUT AN AVERAGE - Any bowler without an average as described, may apply to TBA for grading prior to submitting an entry. If no such application is received, then an entering average of 180 for Men and 170 for Women will apply.

Note: Any bowler may enter in OPEN Grade.

AVERAGE REVIEW - The Tournament Director reserves the right to review the average and regrade any bowler at any time. Participation using an incorrect average may result in disqualification.

REPLACEMENTS - Any change from the original Entry or line-up must be reported to the Tournament Room prior to the scheduled starting time.

GAMES TO BE PLAYED - In each Grade a three (3) game series will be played in Teams, Doubles and Singles.

MULTIPLE PARTICIPATION - TEAMS - In team events at least one partner must be changed. Bowlers may have a maximum of 4 entries.

DOUBLES - Bowlers may have 4 entries maximum which must be with a different partner.

SINGLES - Bowlers may have **4 entries maximum 2 in their own grade and 2 in any grade above their own.**

ALL EVENTS - An All Events Champion will be declared for each grade in which paid entries are received. Scores from each bowler's first Teams, Doubles and Singles will count towards their All Events total. Eligibility is subject to the payment of the **\$6.00 ALL EVENTS FEE**. This Fee must be paid BEFORE bowling in the Australian Disability Championships.

AWARDS: Medals will be presented for 1st, 2nd & 3rd places in all grades for Singles, Doubles, Teams & All Events. Additionally, Trophies will be presented for the Highest Game overall (Male & Female), Highest Series overall (Male & Female) and Highest Pins over average overall (Male and Female) based on bowlers all events score. NOTE - Any matters arising which are not covered by these Tournament Rules will be determined by the TBA Disabilities Tournament Committee.

SMOKING and CONSUMPTION of ALCOHOL will be prohibited during a session of continuous games. Contravening this rule will incur penalties defined in the TBA Code of Conduct.

MOBILE PHONES Competitors mobile phones must be turned off while competing in an event.

CODE OF CONDUCT: Tenpin Bowling Australia's Code of conduct will apply to this tournament.

STATE TEAM CHALLENGE

Rules - Regulations - Requirements

Version 3.0, 27-9-10

1. These Rules will apply for the conduct and control of the TBA Australian Disability Championships State Team Challenge and related matters.
2. The TBA Australian Disability Championships State Team Challenge was established by the TBA Disabilities Committee in response to the wishes of bowlers with disabilities and their carers following requests for increased options and for furthering their bowling careers.
3. **NAME**
 - a) The Tournament will be known as the TBA Australian Disability Championships State Team Challenge and will have a Scratch Division and a Handicap Division.
 - b) The Scratch Division winners will be presented with the Campbelltown Trophies perpetual trophy.
 - c) The Handicap Division winners will be presented with the Narellan Trophies perpetual trophy.
4. **PURPOSE**
 - a) The purpose of the TBA Australian Disability Championships State Team Challenge is to determine annually the best State/Territory representative team of tenpin bowlers in the scratch and handicap Division, each consisting of five players per team.
 - b) To foster, develop and advance a spirit of good sportsmanship and fellowship, to promote and maintain a good relationships amongst the representative teams and to advance their mutual interest in relation to bowling and identify talent for selection into Development Squads and Australian representative teams.
5. **STATES/TERRITORIES TO BE REPRESENTED**

Participation in the TBA Australian Disability Championships State Team Challenge will be limited to one team from the following States and Territories:-

 - a) Queensland
 - b) New South Wales
 - c) Victoria
 - d) Tasmania
 - e) South Australia
 - f) Western Australia
 - g) Australian Capital Territory
 - h) Northern Territory

6. ELIGIBILITY - TEAM MEMBER

Each person:

- a) Must be a current financial member of a TBA Licensed Association or Registered Centre, in good standing.
- b) In the Scratch Division, have an average of 140 or higher at time of selection or Roll off.
- c) In the Handicap Division, have an average of 139 or below at the time of selection or Roll-off.
- d) Must be capable of conducting themselves in such a manner so as not to reflect discredit on TBA, the State/Territory they are representing or tenpin bowling.
- e) Must have qualified for Team Membership in accordance with the conditions set down by the State/Territory Committee in charge of selection.
- f) Must meet the TBA criteria of a Bowler with a Disability except for Managers, Coaches and Support Personnel

Each competitor:

- g) Must have bowled a minimum of 24 games in a League within a TBA Registered Centre.
- f) Must meet the TBA criteria of a Bowler with a Disability
- g) Must have completed an All Events entry in the Championships prior to participation in the TBA Australian Disability Championships State Team Challenge.

Coaches:

All applicants for the position of Coach of a State/Territory Team must hold at least a current level 2 Accreditation under the TBA National Coaching Accreditation Scheme. If none are available or there are insufficient Level 2 or higher Coaches applying, then the State/Territory /Zone must apply to TBA for a suitable coach to be selected from the Coaches Draft.

Managers:

All applicants for the position of Manager of a State/Territory Team must hold a State Team Manager's Certificate.

Selectors:

Parents or relatives (including de facto) of bowlers who have an application for Team selection will not be permitted to serve in any way whatsoever on a selection committee for the Disability State Team Challenge, nor will it be acceptable for them to exercise any degree of influence on any such committee or member of the committee.

7. SELECTION OF TEAMS

- a) Teams will be selected by the Disabilities Committee of their respective State/Territory Association.
- b) The manner of selection of the scratch teams will be on scratch results during the State or Territory Championships or Roll-off conducted for team selection.
- c) The manner of selection of the handicap teams will be on pinfall plus handicap results during the State or Territory Championships or Roll-off conducted for team selection.
- d) Individual bowler's record sheets must be provided to TBA.
- e) The roster of players for each team in the TBA Australian Disability Championships State Team Challenge may not exceed eight (8) players. The actual playing strength/line-up for any match will be five (5) players

drawn from the roster submitted.

- f) All players must participate in at least 1 round, except in cases of emergency.
- g) Each State/Territory Disability Committee must advise the Tournament Director not less than sixty (60) days prior to the commencement of the TBA Australian Disability State Team Challenge of the names and details of their Team Members. Failure to provide this information by the prescribed time may result in a forfeit by that State/Territory.
- h) Any State that requires an additional bowler at any time for any reason must abide by the TBA State Team Draft Bowler Policy.

8. VENUE

The annual TBA Australian Disability Championships State Team Challenge will be conducted in the principal centre used for the conduct of the TBA Australian Disabilities Championships, and will take place on the second last day of the Championships.

9. CONTROL OF MATCHES

TBA will appoint the principal Tournament Director who will be responsible for all Tournament preparations, and conduct of the matches whilst in progress. The appointed Tournament Director may appoint/engage such assistance as deemed necessary to ensure the successful conduct of the Tournament.

10. FORMAT FOR MATCHES

- a) Teams will be opposed against each other for one complete round of matches over such time as may be considered necessary, according to the number of participating teams. Each match will be one full team game, and in the event of two or more teams not being represented, the number of matches will be determined by the Tournament Director.
- b) In the event that an odd number of States/Territories are represented, the team without an opponent in each round will be given maximum points. If a team withdraws during the competition, all teams that have played that team will be given maximum points retrospectively.
- c) In the event that one or more of the nominated team members are unable to bowl prior to the commencement of or during the actual Tournament as the result of an emergency, such that five (5) players are not available to play, the team will be filled by such eligible bowlers as are necessary, provided that they were part of the State Disabilities Selection or Roll-offs. Verification by the State/Territory of the bowler's eligibility will be required. The decision as to what constitutes an emergency will be determined by the Tournament Director.

11. POINTS SYSTEM

Points will be awarded as follows:

- a) Scratch event:
 - i) Each team member will be matched against the opposing team member in the corresponding position in the line-up and the bowler achieving the highest total pinfall for the game will win one (1) point for the Team. In the event of an equal game score, the point will be equally shared.
 - ii) The team's total pinfall will be compared with the total pinfall of the opposing team and two (2) points will be awarded to the team with the highest total pinfall. (7) points in total.
 - iii) In the event of an equal team score, the points will be equally shared

- b) Handicap event:
 - i) Each team member will be matched against the opposing team member in the corresponding position in the line-up and the bowler achieving the highest total pinfall plus handicap for the game will win one (1) point for the Team. In the event of an equal game score, the point will be equally shared.
 - ii) The team's total pinfall plus handicap will be compared with the total pinfall plus handicap of the opposing team and two (2) points will be awarded to the team with the highest total pinfall plus handicap. (7) points in total.
 - iii) In the event of an equal team score, the points will be equally shared
- c)
 - i) At the conclusion of the rounds of matches, the team having the highest number of points in each Division will be declared the TBA Australian Championships State/Territory Champion for the year for that Division.
 - ii) In the event of two or more teams having the same number of points in the scratch Division, the tie will be broken by the team with the highest total pinfall.
 - iii) In the event of two or more teams having the same number of points in the handicap Division, the tie will be broken by the team with the highest total pinfall plus handicap.
 - iv) If a tie still exists in either Division, Managers will select 5 bowlers each who will play a 9th and 10th frame to break the tie.
 - v) Each bowler will bowl 2 frames according to their placing on the roster provided to the Tournament Director. In the handicap Division, 2/10 of each bowlers handicap will be added to their pinfall. Fractions of handicap must be ignored.
 - vi) Points will be allocated as defined in 11. b) i) and ii). In the event of a further tie in the playoff total points, playoff pinfall will be used to break the tie in the scratch Division and pinfall plus handicap will be used in the handicap Division.

12. TBA AUSTRALIAN DISABILITY CHAMPIONSHIPS STATE TEAM CHALLENGE TROPHY

- a) The TBA Australian Disability Championships State Team Challenge Trophy for each Division will be presented to the Captains of the winning teams during the medals presentation. Each team member will receive a memento, inscribed to commemorate the Team's achievement.
- b) The TBA Australian Disability Championships State Team Challenge Trophies are perpetual trophies and will remain in the custody of the Champion State/Territory to be displayed in the various bowling centres and offices throughout the State/Territory until the commencement of the next Tournament.

13. OTHER MATTERS

- a) Any other matter that may arise during the course of the Tournament that are not covered in the above mentioned Rules and Regulations will be resolved by the Tournament Committee and/or the Tournament Director as deemed appropriate.
- b) All members of the State Teams including Bowlers, Coaching Staff, Management and Support Staff are to refrain from the consuming alcoholic beverages during the Tournament. Any person found under the influence of alcohol or consuming alcohol during the Tournament will be withdrawn from the competition immediately.
