Rules and Regulations

1. ELIGIBILITY

This Tournament is open to all TBA members bowlers who have a disability. TBA defines a bowler with a disability as a person who suffers from a condition that has limitation, restriction or impairment that restricts everyday activity. The condition is permanent. It should be noted that degree or degrees of pain are not considered disability.

To prove a disability, a bowler needs to provide one of the following types of evidence, if requested:

- Valid Disability Support Pension Card (DSP);
- Recipient of the Child Disability Allowance;
- Classification Card issued by TBAL, Deaf Sports Australia, Blind Sports Australia, Wheelchair Sports Australia or AUSRAPID (or state affiliated organisation);
- Letter from a medical or educational professional:
 - Physiotherapist or Occupational Therapist;
 - Principal of Primary, Secondary or Tertiary Education Organisation;
 - Psychologist;
 - General Medical Practitioner;
 - Audiologist; or
 - Ophthalmologist;
- Visual evidence in the case of short statured or participants that are amputees. An amputee at the site of a major joint, including the loss of a foot or both feet, an arm or both arms.

Each bowler must be able to provide evidence of their disability at any time during the Tournament if requested.

Any bowler who is unsure of their eligibility to compete should apply to the Tournament Committee for final ruling. Bowlers may be asked to provide written medical information. It is the bowlers responsibility to ensure evidence in support of their disability can be produced. Failure to produce acceptable evidence may result in disqualification with further participation in the tournament not permitted.

2. ENTERING AVERAGES

Bowlers must use their highest average in any league or accredited tournament over a minimum of 18 games as at December 31, 2012. If a bowler uses special equipment to aid in delivering the ball, averages must be established using that equipment.

Bowlers without an average must apply to the Tournament Director for Grading, before submitting an Entry.

3. THREE GAME SERIES

In each Grade and Event, entrants in Teams, Doubles and Singles, will bowl a three game series. The highest series in each Grade and Event will win.

4. PRIZES

Medallions will be awarded to First, Second and Third place in each Grade and Event. All Bowlers will receive a Participation Certificate. Individual awards will be presented for Male and Female, High Series, Highest over Average and High Game. There will be separate divisions for Male & Female Singles and All Events.

Teams and Doubles events may be Mixed.

5. ALL EVENTS (OPTIONAL ALL EVENTS FEE \$2)

An All Events Champion will be declared in every Grade. A bowler's first appearance in Teams, Doubles and Singles will count towards the All Events score. Entering average will determine All Events classification, unless application is received to upgrade a bowlers All Events entry.

6. **MULTIPLE PARTICIPATION:**

Teams -3 Bowlers per team Bowlers will be allowed unlimited entries in Teams, although each entry must be with at least one different team member. Same combinations will

not be permitted.

Bowlers will be allowed unlimited entries in Doubles. Each entry must be with a different partner.

Singles

Bowlers may have unlimited entries in their Grade or any Grade above their own classification.

NATIONAL TENPIN BOWLING CHAMPIONSHIPS For People with a disability

2nd Annual Open & Restricted Masters Friday, 14th June 2013

Final to be held at AMF Belconnen 1 Emu Bank Belconnen, ACT

Open to TBA members who meet the definition of a bowler with a disability and who have completed an All Events entry at the 2013 National Tenpin Bowling Championships for People with a disability.

<u>OPEN MASTERS:</u> This is a scratch event open to male and female bowlers whose entering averages for the championships is 140 and above.

<u>RESTRICTED MASTERS:</u> This is a handicap event based on 100% of 200 open to all male and female bowlers whose entering average for the championships is 139 and below.

<u>FORMAT:</u> Top 16 qualifiers will compete in the final (State Masters winners have automatic entry). Vacancies will be filled by qualifiers, with 2 reserves for each Masters.

<u>QUALIFYING:</u> Qualifying will be the highest 3 game series in either a singles or doubles entry (plus handicap for the restricted division) bowled during the championship from the start of competition on 7th June 8am squad until the final squad Thursday 13th June. Any singles or doubles attempt used for qualifying will incur an additional qualifying fee of \$5 which must be paid in the tournament room prior to the squad. Masters list will be updated after each squad and displayed within the centre. Bowlers who are not in attendance at close of qualifying will be notified of their position for the Masters.

COST: \$80.00. FOR BOTH OPEN AND RESTRICTED MASTERS. TO BE PAID AT CHECK IN ON Friday 14th June 2013 at 8.30am.

CHECK IN: 8.30AM SHARP. ABSENT BOWLERS NAMES WILL BE CALLED THREE (3) TIMES. IF NOT IN CENTRE AFTER 3RD CALL RESERVES WILL BE CALLED IN ORDER.

PLAY TO COMMENCE AT 9.00AM.

<u>FORMAT:</u> Bowling 8 games, moving after every 2 game block within each Masters. (Open with open bowlers etc.) Top 3 scratch series for the Open and top 3 series with Handicap for the Restricted will then contest a 1 game step ladder. 3rd plays 2nd and winner plays 1st. 1st place getter has right of re-challenge if they lose their 1 game in the final.

PRIZES: FOR BOTH OPEN AND RESTRICTED MASTERS.

1st place: \$200 plus trophy and shirt. 2nd place: \$120 3rd place: \$100

PLEASE NOTE: PRIZE FUND WILL BE REDUCED IF LESS THAN 16 BOWLERS COMPETE

The Tournament Committee is responsible for holding and running these events and all matters concerning the Masters events will be determined by the Masters Tournament Director in conjunction with the Tournament Committee. Their decision will be final.
